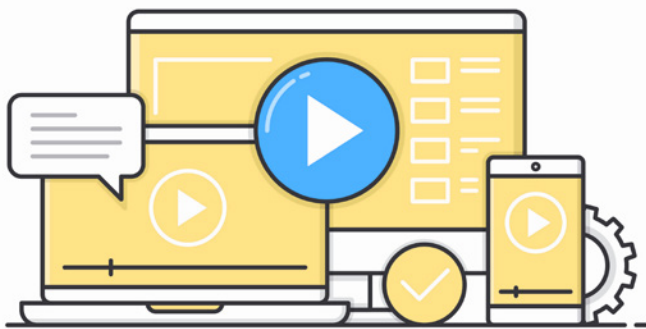

Students can read what they want, when they want – we do encourage students to select print and digital materials at their reading level, though this is not required. Many schools and the Beaufort County Library already have summer reading programs in place, and guess what? Those books count for our BCSD Summer Reading Challenge too! The students **READ** what books they want or need to, **LOG** their minutes of reading by completing an easy online form, and if they meet the requirements below they will **EARN** recognition and a certificate of completion upon returning to school in the fall!

RESOURCES, REFLECTION AND SUPPORT

Parents of participating students will also get access to an online Facebook group where they will be directed to reading resources and recommendations, find opportunities for their students to reflect on their reading, get technical support for completing the virtual reading logs, and more!



WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Beaufort County School District students who are rising to Kindergarten through 8th grade in the 2018-19 school year.

CHALLENGE REQUIREMENTS

K- Grade 4: 800 minutes in 8 weeks. This averages to 20 minutes of reading per week day.

Grades 5-8: 1200 minutes in 8 weeks. This averages to 30 minutes of reading per week day.

Students are encouraged to read beyond these requirements when possible!
