Based on our Fall MAP results we have a large percentage of students (grades 3-5) in math and reading that fall in the A/M/E (Approaching, Meets, Exceeds) categories. We need to move more of the students from the Approaches category into the Meets/Exceeds category. This will make a big difference in end of the year scores.
